### Group Ride Code of Conduct

The following is a Code of Conduct that members of the Green Knights Chapter 93 will follow when conducting, participating in any group rides whether sponsored by the GK 93 or as guests on another motorcycle club group ride. In doing so, the GK 93 will continue to support the GK 93 MMC purpose to establish and maintain a spirit of comradeship and esprit de corps that will enhance the prestige of all motorcycle riders, encourage on-going rider education and skills development, and reduce the potential of motorcycle mishaps. Set an example for all personnel according to the standards, traditions, and customs of the U.S. Army. To operate and conduct itself in a manner that provides equal opportunity and treatment for all motorcyclists. This list is not all inclusive.

- All riders will follow instruction from the Road Captain
- All riders will ride safely with the group
- All riders will follow at correct intervals, affording ample space for the forward riders actions
- All riders will follow the laws and regulations of the host nation
- All riders will maintain their location within the group ride unless the situation becomes unsafe
- If necessary, all riders will only pass within the group when the situation allows for safe passing
- All riders will assist each other in the case of a mechanical break down or accident
- All riders will assist in the coaching and mentoring of new riders on group rides
- All riders will inform a fellow member if a unsafe act is witnessed
- All riders will accept notification of unsafe riding and will adjust their riding accordingly during a group ride
- All riders will inform the Sgt at Arms of any unsafe acts

Any violations of the group ride code of conduct will be brought forth to the current governing body of the GK 93 for discussion and any decision will be discussed and voted on for action by the membership at the following monthly meeting.
